MY COMMUNITY MEMBER WAS ARRESTED BY ICE, WHAT DO I DO?

- $\hfill\square$ Gather information from family / community:
 - 🗆 Name
 - □ A-number (if available this is the 9 digit number that appears on immigration documents)
 - □ Date of birth
 - $\hfill\square$ Country of origin
 - \square Any information about immigration status or pending applications for status
 - $\hfill\square$ Date of ICE arrest
 - $\hfill\square$ Location of ICE arrest
 - □ Does the person already have an immigration attorney?
 - 🗆 If yes, name, phone number

□ Use A-number and Country of Birth, or Name and Date of Birth and Country of Birth to try to locate the person on the <u>ICE Detainee Locator</u>

□ If you can identify the detention center (it might take some time to be in the system), locate information about visitation <u>here</u>.

 $\hfill\square$ If the information is not in the detainee locator, some options might be to:

□ Try different variations of their name (for example, if a person has multiple last names, one last name may be used, both may be separated, or they may be hyphenated)

□ Call the Local <u>ICE Field Office</u>

□ Call nearby county jails with ICE contracts

□ If the person <u>has</u> an immigration attorney, notify the immigration attorney with as much information above as you were able to gather

□ If the person <u>does not</u> have an immigration attorney, contact a <u>legal resources hotline</u> in your area or a local community organization (<u>here</u> or <u>here</u>) to ask about nonprofits or lists of trusted referrals

□ <u>Ready to Stay</u> has a list of immigration attorneys, as does the <u>Immigration Advocates Network</u>. Each immigration court also maintains <u>a list of pro bono legal services providers</u>. Keep in mind many nonprofits do not provide detained representation, so there might be a waitlist at the organizations that do.

$\hfill\square$ Determine any needs of the family - Community organizations may be able to support

- $\hfill\square$ Kid drop-off and pick-up at school
- □ Last paycheck pick-up
- □ Car pick-up
- $\hfill\square$ Grocery funds
- $\hfill\square$ Commissary/ phone funds for the detained person
- $\hfill\square$ After school care for kiddos
- □ Accessing bank accounts or pausing utilities

□ Does the detained person need to execute a Power of Attorney from detention? Call the detention center to determine how to get visitation with a notary.
